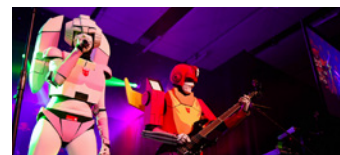
The pivot to offering a virtual event for fans has been one of the most challenging and rewarding experiences of my time at Dragon Con. There was never a question when we made the decision to cancel the in-person convention whether we would want to offer something FREE to our fans over Labor Day weekend. While I know most folks know exactly what they want to see, do, and experience during an in-person Dragon Con, Dragon Con Goes Virtual is a bit different. I encourage you to read through this guide, meant to gather as many details on our plans this weekend to build the best virtual Dragon Con possible. In particular, I want to point out that there are several ways to support some key partners and groups. First we set out to create a virtual marketplace with our partners at eventeny for our vendors and artists, who have been hit very hard with the pandemic shutting down conventions for the most part, allowing our fans to shop without the crowded halls or limited hours.

As if that experience wasn't enough, we've also added a vendor channel to our Discord server, encouraging a way of communication directly between vendor and fan to replicate that show interaction that is important to so many. For guests,



we've again partnered with Epic who generally offer our photo ops with our guests. They have been hard at work building a platform to allow fans to connect with guests through virtual meet and greets and coming up with a process to still get your autographs from those guests participating in Dragon Con Goes Virtual. We know it isn't quite the same as those super cool interactions experienced often at Dragon Con, but it is an awesome way to support the guests and explore a new (and we believe very cool) way to connect with them.

What makes Dragon Con Goes Virtual special in my eyes? It's you of course, and we have tried really hard to build this virtual experience to reflect that by incorporating you in as many aspects as possible including the virtual parade (clearly in my top three things to watch this weekend as my team has kept it a secret from even me), the Friday Night Costuming Contest, the Masquerade and Hallway Costume Contests, and my very favorite, the Dragon Con Love Notes where several of our fans, partners, and guests strive to give us all a big ole' virtual hug when all of us most desperately need one. If you haven't taken part in any of these offerings and would still like to, there is still time to send us a Love Note with the DCTV team reviewing and dropping them in the stream throughout the weekend – you can't get much more included than that!

And one final way we wanted to include you is reflected in this very guide. Every year, we comb through all of the photos our lovely Dragon Con photography team has taken over the course of the event the year before. This year, after spending days poring over the tens of thousands of 2019 photos looking for the "perfect match" to put on the cover of this book, we kept hitting a wall with the best representation of Dragon Con Goes Virtual. VITAL INFORMATION WE CAN'T FORGET TO TELL YOU

(BECAUSE IT'S **SUPER** IMPORTANT)

As you may have already heard, our little convention is going viral (and we don't mean another pandemic. We've had enough of those). We're traveling back to the early 1990s when the internet first became widely available and we weren't spending our days sitting in the dark saying "wait, that was almost 30 years ago?" Back when the internet had that fresh, new world wide web smell, and the "dulcet" sounds of the Hamster Dance rang in our ears...pretty much daily. When technology is once again upending our world, we at Dragon Con are turning back to the nostalgic feel of 127.0.0.1 (home) and bringing your favorite convention to you. This book is your all-access passport to all things Dragon Con Goes Virtual.

Here you will find schedules of our three broadcast channels, information about your favorite fan tracks, and anything else we can possibly squeeze in to help make your virtual con experience out of this world!

POLICIES

Even though Dragon Con has gone virtual, we have created online experiences and forums for our Fans, Members, Guests, Professionals, Program Participants, Dealers, Exhibitors, or Volunteers to interact and engage with one another over the course of the event. We pride Dragon Con on being a safe place, where everybody is welcome and anybody can be whomever they desire. Even so, certain kinds of offensive or harassing behavior are not tolerated. To the best of our ability, we intend to eliminate inappropriate conduct from the convention.

It is very important that if you are being harassed in any way, you report it immediately to the moderators of these various platforms. We cannot address anything that we are not made aware of and we need whatever detail can be provided. Dragon Con and its agents reserve the right to revoke or suspend access to these platforms to protect users. If an individual breaks the rules of the convention, he or she may be barred from convention activities, either for several hours (to sober up, perhaps) or for the rest of the event. Each platform will have its set of rules, so be sure to check each area for guidelines and expectations.

DRAGON CON GOES VIRTUAL BROADCASTS

We fully acknowledge that a virtual event won't come close to offering the magic that an in person Dragon Con brings, but it is our hope that it will allow our community to take some time to step off the planet that is currently experiencing an unprecedented global pandemic for five days to be among people who get you. People who are just like you. People who truly accept you. And hey, if you wanna cosplay in front of your computer...that's cool, we will be doing the same (and running some awesome contests for you to show off your work!)

For real, what you can expect is three totally unique and awesome channels running throughout the event plus a whole slew of fun things going on across our social platforms.

- **Classics:** The first channel will be our DCTVLand/Classics feed which will feature all sorts of content from years past. Did you miss the John Barrowman panel with his gorgeous TARDIS dress on display? We've got you. Sad to have not yet seen the first show William Shatner and Leonard Nimoy shared the stage at Dragon Con? We wouldn't dream of excluding that gem.
- **Fan Tracks:** The second channel will feature our amazing track programming, something that we truly believe sets us apart from all of the other conventions out there. We have our 35+ tracks busy at work generating new content for you all to enjoy 24 hours a day. No matter your interest, we have you covered.
- **Main:** The third and final channel, what we are considering to be the Main Channel, will highlight new guest programming, performances from quintessential Dragon Con performers, and two of the biggest and best costume contests we host each year among many other exciting programming items including our annual parade.

We'll be streaming Dragon Con live primarily on our existing streaming site at <https://dragoncon.tv/virtual>.

All three channels will be live on that site all weekend long, but because we're streaming live for free, you'll also be able to watch on a few other platforms:

- Through the Vimeo iOS or Android App. Subscribe to <https://vimeo.com/dragoncontv>. This app also supports casting to devices through Chromecast and Apple AirPlay.
- Select content like the Parade will also be streamed to our [YouTube channel](#).
- We also have a [Roku channel](#) so you'll be able to watch on your big screen at. If all else fails or you prefer not to click a link, you can just search for "Dragon Con" on the Roku channel store and we should be the first result.

STREAMING MEMBERSHIP

You may be asking yourself how on earth you can keep up with it all because you just want it ALL. We don't expect to and we totally get it. We will have all Dragon Con Goes Virtual programming available for playback through our \$10 streaming memberships after the show, which is normally \$30 for non-members – whoa, what a deal. This [streaming membership](#) will also provide you access to our full programming catalog to really enjoy the nostalgia of Dragon Cons past if you just can't get enough through our Dragon Con Goes Virtual experience.
